1957 National Champions

1958 Rose Bowl Champions (10-7 Victory Over Oregon)

1958 – Threw 25 yard touchdown pass and scored a two point conversion against Michigan. Jerry recovered a Michigan fumble at the Ohio State 2-yard line on the next to last play. Final Score: Ohio State – 20 Michigan – 14 (Attendance: 83,248)

1959 – 75 Yard punt against Wisconsin, a Big 10 record that stood for 13 years

1958 & 1959-VARSITY “O” CLUB

Professional Football 1961-1964

1961 NFL DRAFT-Drafted in the 13th Round by the New York Giants

After apparently earning a spot on the Giant roster, Jerry suffered a knee injury and was released.

1961- Jerry signs with the rival New York Titans/Jets of the new American Football League (AFL). 1961 & 1962 Jerry is the Titans/Jets Middle Linebacker

CANADIAN FOOTBALL LEAGUE 1963-1964

1963 – Jerry signs with the Montreal Alouettes of the CFL

1964 – Jerry completes his pro career with Montreal playing quarterback, running back and linebacker. He had 18 carries and 3 pass receptions for Montreal in 1964, including one catch for a touchdown.
