- Design and make your own t-shirt.
 - Illustrate a scene or character from the book on a t-shirt
 - Write a short summary of the scene and explain why it is important to the story. If you choose to illustrate a character, write a description of the character and why he or she is important to the story.

- Create a mobile from items related to the story.
 - Select 10 items that represent people, places, events or other parts of the book and hang them from a hanger using string or yarn.
 - Write a key that explains each object and why you chose it.

- Create a diorama of a scene from the book.
 - Create a scene from the book in a shoebox.
 - Write a description of what the scene shows.

- Make a map of places where the story takes place.
 - The map should be colored.
 - Write a description of what each place is and why it is important.

- Create a board game or card game about the book.
 - The game should include details about the setting, characters, and plot to show knowledge of the book.
 - Include instructions about how to play.
